## Committee Updates

### Events—Deb Babcock

- The Events Committee has been quite busy. On Saturday, April 26, we hosted 75 visitors who were part of the Maude Kerns Artist Studio Tour. Lots of volunteers from Clay Space made this event run smoothly -- from elegant snacks made by Jackie Clark, to the 12 members who served as tour guides, to our four featured artists, and a few members who opened their private studios for people to poke their head into.
- Coming up, we have another **Studio Tour** from 11 am 1 pm on Sunday, May 25 that is open to family and friends of all Clay Space members as well as the members of Local Clay, the group that puts on Clay Fest. Lee Dwyer is heading up this event.
- On Friday, May 30 from 6 pm 8 pm, Clay Space will be open for the Whiteaker Last Friday Art Walk. We will allow visitors into the Gallery, East Classroom and as far down the hallway as the Featured Artist and Challenge displays. We plan to offer refreshments and possibly have a demo or other activity in the East Classroom.
- Sunday, June 8th, is a big fundraising event for Clay Space, headed up by Cathy McGrath, Cecilia Story and Jeff Keating. We are collaborating with Whiteaker Printmakers and Wildling Collaborative Arts to host the Second Avenue Art Fest in the parking lot next door. A food truck, live music, demo tent, kids play-in-clay tent, and around 50 vendors will fill the lot from 11 am - 5 pm. See notice below about vending or voluneering.
- The shelving in the hallway between classrooms is up and running, showcasing our May Featured Artist: Megan Anderson, and another set of shelves is for members who have work to show featuring the Challenge Theme: NESTING.
